PDMS Integration- not covered/presented clearly; members are assigned content by managers; video library does not seem to cover the need of the District; this seems to be just access to a library that does not seem to cater to the District instructional needs

Doesn't say it uses Canvas; seems to have its own LMS; not much in terms of videos on topics relevant to education; often says, "will create" which implies they don't have it and "will customize" for us; this may take a longer time period

Did not address Online Video Library Requirements according to the RFP requirements

Cost does not reflect service

No single sign on; someone has to import users- not automatic; some PDMS features willing to add more if needed
