What is Freckle?

Freckle is an online learning platform that allows students to practice Math, English Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies at their own level.

How will my child access Freckle?

Your child can access Freckle by going through **Clever**. Your child should use his/her MSIS # (lunch number) and birthdate to access Clever.

Username: MSIS#@jpsms.org (ex. 00123456@jpsms.org)

Password: Child's Birthdate (ex. 07012006)



What can you do at home to help?

- Provide a quiet place for your child to work.
- Check your child's homework after he or she completes it each night.
- Talk with your child about how practicing Freckle at home will help prepare for classwork.
- Encourage your child to take each lesson and question seriously. Emphasize "think before clicking," because just clicking through will not give an accurate report of what your child knows and is able to do.
- Encourage your child to use the tools provided during the lessons (**hints, videos, key terms, etc.**) and to use scratch paper for math computation.
- To review and discuss your child's results, click the "**My Backpack or My Teacher**" page. Make sure to click the **DONE** tab.

How many types of practices does Freckle have to offer?

Freckle offers two types of practices – Targeted Practice and Adaptive Practice.

Targeted Practice allows the student to practice grade-level skills (ex. A 9th grade student will be assigned 9th grade skills).

Adaptive Practice allows the student to practice at their individual level. For example, a 4th grade child may be working on 5th grade skills. **Freckle** continuously adapts to your child's individual skills, so he or she is getting the appropriate challenge, whether they're working below, at, or above grade level.

Does work completed in Social Studies and Science count towards my progress?

Yes, the data for these subjects can be found in the ELA reports.

Does time work in Freckle over the weekend count?

Yes, **Freckle** data is updated for the week on Sunday.

What is expected of your child?

Your child must complete **Math Adaptive Practice** and **ELA Skills Practice** **BOTH** at a minimum of 4 sessions per week.

What is the minimum required time for my child?

- **Elementary**
 - 15 – 20 minutes per day/per subject
- **Middle**
 - 20 – 30 minutes per day/per subject
- **High**
 - 15 – 20 minutes per A or B day/per subject
