We are pleased to announce that for a consecutive 4th year in a row, Power APAC has received an A-rating from the Mississippi Department of Education. Our scholars increased their proficiency rates by 10% in both math and reading to 80%. Our 4th Grade reading classes were 2nd in the State last year for proficiency! 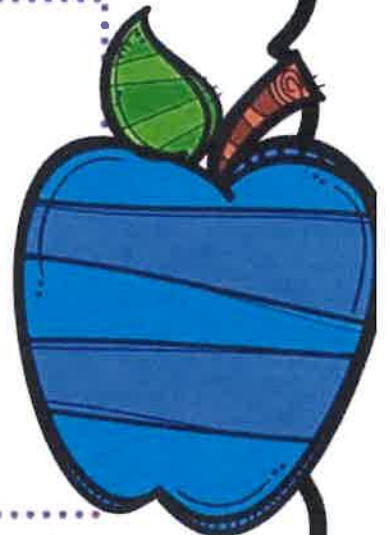
