Students will receive Carnegie units for successfully completing the following courses while in middle school.

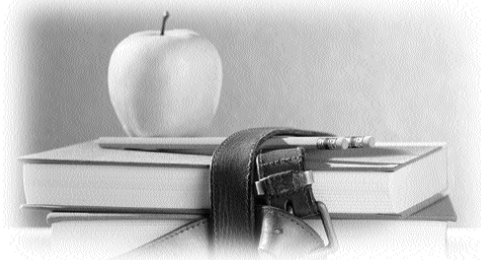
