Skills and Assessments

Reading/Language: Scholars will read historical, scientific, and technical texts and explain what happened and why. Scholars will identify and explain the text structure the author uses.

<u>Math:</u> Scholars will be adding and subtracting mixed numbers with like denominators and by replacing each mixed number with an equivalent fraction.

Students will use properties of operations and the relationship between addition and subtraction. .

Social Studies: Examine the rights and freedoms given to citizens.

<u>Science:</u> Scholars will plan and conduct scientific investigations to test how different variables affect the properties of sound.
