Skills and Assessments

Scholars will also explain how an author uses reasons and evidence to support particular points in a text.

<u>Math:</u> Scholars will solve real world problems involving multiplication of fractions and mixed numbers, e.g., by using visual fraction models or equations to represent the problem.

<u>Social Studies</u>: Scholars will explain the central role of the expansion of slavery in causing the Civil War.

<u>Science:</u> Scholars will obtain and communicate information describing gravity's effect on an object.
