

SUPERINTENDENT'S LEGAL STATUS

The term “superintendent” shall mean the chief executive officer of the school district. It is the responsibility of the superintendent to administer the schools within the district and to implement the decisions of the school board. No person shall be eligible to hold the office of superintendent of schools unless such person meets the statutory and Mississippi Department of Education requirements. The board has the statutory power and authority to select the superintendent for a period not exceeding four scholastic years.
