

PUBLIC INFORMATION SYSTEM

It is the desire of the Board that the citizens of the community be fully informed of the official action of the board, programs, and activities of the district.

News media representatives shall be welcome to attend all regular and special meetings of the Board. Any behavior or actions perceived as disruptive or diverting from the action of the meeting will not be permitted.

All representatives of the media shall be given equal access to information about the district's schools subject to limitations by law. General releases of interest to the entire district shall be made available to all media.

The Board directs the Superintendent to make the public fully aware of all aspects of the schools by:

Keeping the public informed regarding the policies, administrative operations, objectives, and educational programs

Furnishing full and accurate information, with interpretation and explanation of the school plans and programs.
