The Board assumes final responsibility for all books and instructional materials it makes available to scholars. However, it recognizes the concerns of parents or legal guardians regarding materials used by their children.

While the Board will not permit an individual or group to exercise censorship over instructional materials and library collections, the provision will be made for the re-evaluation of the materials upon formal request. On the other hand, the right of scholars to learn and the freedom of teachers to teach shall be respected.
