Program Description

The Jackson Public School Office of Innovative Strategy has provided after-school learning opportunities for at Wingfield High School. This creative and fun space has allowed scholars the opportunities to meet new friends, explore new interests, and learn new and exciting things all while fostering healthy relationships and a sense of community. The afterschool staff and mentors provide a caring and nurturing environment that allows all students to develop life skills beyond the classroom.

The primary focus of Wingfield's afterschool program is to ensure that all learners are college and career ready by providing enrichment in the state tested areas of Algebra I, Biology I, English II, and US History as well as ACT prep with Sylvan. Wingfield has also partnered with Jackson State University Trio (Upward Bound, and Talent Search) to provide students with resources needed to explore options beyond high school. The afterschool experience and partnerships work to provide students with mentoring, social emotional learning, financial literacy, and college and career readiness skills needed for success within the classroom and beyond.
