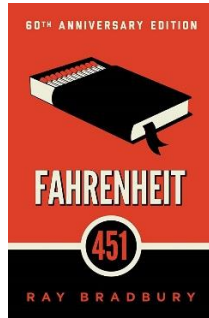


# Hooray for 9<sup>th</sup> Grade!!!!!!!

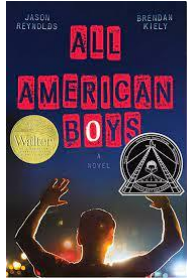
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## PARENTS!!!!!!!!!!

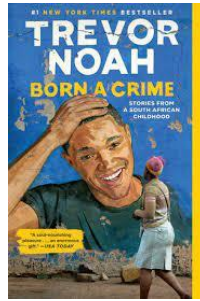

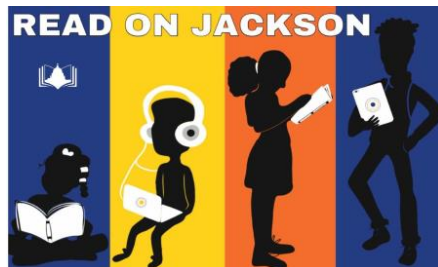

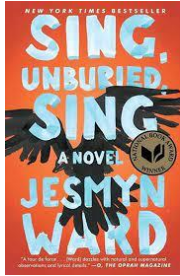
